



## New palliative care unit opens at St Martha's Regional Hospital

ANTIGONISH, N.S. – A new palliative care unit at St Martha's Regional Hospital in Antigonish was officially opened today.

The renovation, which began in January, 2018, created a six-bed palliative care unit.

"This unit would not be possible without the vision of the former Guysborough Antigonish Strait Health Authority leadership and strong community support," said Martha Cooper, Site Lead at St Martha's Regional Hospital.

St Martha's Regional Hospital Foundation contributed \$600,000 for capital costs, while St Martha's Regional Hospital Auxiliary donated \$150,000 in furnishings and equipment.

In addition to medical equipment and necessary staff space requirements, the new unit includes areas for families and volunteers. Amenities such as shower and laundry facilities allow families and friends to remain on the unit, close to their loved ones in care.

The patient rooms are equipped with new televisions, family space and pull-out couches for overnight stays. The new unit also has a full kitchen, computer room and quiet spaces throughout and reflects a person-centred, serene and homelike environment.
